

WE ARE NOW ACCEPTING THE FE EXAM VERIFICATION IN LIEU OF GRE SCORES FOR THE NON-THESIS MASTERS DEGREE PROGRAM!

If you are planning on applying to the Civil and Coastal Engineering department and will be pursuing a Master's non-thesis degree, you can use your FE results. However, please note that if you send (or have sent) in your GRE scores, we will consider your application using your GRE score and not the FE exam verification. If your GRE score falls below our departmental requirement of 1100, you will be asked to re-take the exam in order to be considered for admission. The FE will not be considered as an option for you at this point.

OBTAINING THE VERIFICATION OF PASSING THE FE EXAM

If you would like to use passage of the FE exam in lieu of the GRE score for application to the non-thesis Masters program, you will need to request the Professional Engineering board of the state in which you passed the FE exam to send official verification to the University of Florida - Graduate Admissions Office, 201 Criser Hall – P.O. Box 114000 - Gainesville, FL 32611-4000.

The verification MUST INCLUDE the date that the Fundamentals of Engineering examination was passed and “FE” somewhere on the document. If the verification that is received doesn't include “FE” on it, the UF Office of Admissions will not allow use of the document. If you took and passed the EI or EIT this pertains to you in particular – the verification can have these on it but it must also include “FE passed on ____/____/____.”

If you took the FE exam in Florida, you may go to the website of the Florida Board of PE at <http://www.fbpe.org> to download a form for Verification of Registration. You must send the application fee and fill out the form to request the Florida Board of Professional Engineers to send verification to our Office of Admissions.

If you took the FE exam in another state, you will need to request the PE board of that state to send an official verification of your passage of the Fundamentals of Engineering exam to the University of Florida Graduate Admissions Office.
